

The Leaving Certificate
Applied is a two-year
programme to prepare
students for adult and
working life.



Course Structure

2 Year Programme

Divided into 4 halfyear blocks called Sessions

Key assignments must be completed during each session

It is continuous assessment-marked over the two years

90% attendance is a major part of this course There are 7 tasks (projects) to complete over the 2 years

Subjects

Students must complete the following subjects in LCA:

- English and Communications
- Mathematical Applications
- Gaeilge (Irish) is covered in 5th year
- French is covered in 6th year
- Vocational Preparation: Guidance, Job-search, Enterprise 1&2, Work Experience 1-4, & Work and Living



Subjects

- Horticulture
- Arts- Drama
- Introduction to Communication and Technology (ICT)
- Engineering
- Social Education
- Leisure and Recreation



Do Leaving Certificate Applied students receive a Leaving Certificate?

- Yes. Students who successfully complete the programme receive a Leaving Certificate from the State Examinations Commission.
- All credits awarded will be recorded on the LCA parchment.



RESULTS: GRADES

Students can get 200 credits over the two years.

62 in school :Attendance and completing Key Assignments

70 from tasks: projects and interviews

68 from exams

- Look for a job
- Get an Apprenticeship
- Apply to do a Post Leaving Certificate Course (PLC)
- Complete PLC course and continue onto college/ University
- Apply to become a guard, army officer, cadet, hotel employee, SOLAS etc.
