Dear Parents,

In the academic year 2024-2025, a trip to Munich will take place during the February Mid-Term Break, 14th-17th of February 2025. The tour is being organised for next year's 6th Year, and 5th Year students.

The cost of this proposed trip will be between €760-840, with a booking deposit of €200 payable before May 24th

The trip includes flights, accommodation, breakfast and an evening meal, various tour guides and transport to and from Dublin Airport and all transfer on the tour itself. Highlights of the trip will include:

Guided tours and admissions to

- Dachau concentration camp,
- Full Day at Nuremberg or Neuschwanstein
- Allianz Arena
- BMW tour
- Olympic TV tower
- Munich city walking tour

This Trip will only cater for 54 students and it will be based on a first come, first served basis, like our other school trips. This trip is open to all 6th year pupils, but if it is oversubscribed, half the number of places will be held for 6th year's who study History. If there is capacity, the same approach will apply to 5th years. Preference will also be giving to a small selection of senior students who missed out on the Iceland trip.

The only way to put your child's name down for this trip is via the survey link which will be shared with parents. This survey will open at 7.00pm on Thursday 25th of April and closes at 7.00pm on Sunday 28th of April 2024.

Please be advised also that payment of a deposit does not guarantee that a student will travel on the tour. Exemplary behaviour is expected of all students intending to travel on any school tour and any serious or persistent breaches of the school's Code of Behaviour between now and the tour date will result in students being excluded from the tour without refund of their initial deposit.
