Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please find enclosed the <u>Subjects</u> allocated to your child, our SPHE/RSE letter and our Way2Pay info letter. Find below relevant information regarding starting school in August.

Our school uniform has been reviewed; please review the changes that have been made. See attached information letter.

The <u>start date</u> for 1<sup>st</sup> year students is Thursday 22nd August - see overall schedule below. You are requested to bring your child to, and collect them from, school on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> August. The <u>Induction Day</u> on the 22<sup>nd</sup> is to familiarize incoming 1st years with their new surroundings and to assist in their transition from primary to post primary level. They need to bring a pen with them, and they will be given their timetable for the rest of the year on the 1<sup>st</sup> day.

## School Fees of €110 must be paid in full by Way2Pay before the 16th of August.

 For Junior pupils, school fees cover School Insurance, Locker, Text messages, Activities & Trips, Mock Exams (Cost spread over all years).

The <u>New Junior Book Grant</u> provides funds for schools to supply as many materials as possible to Junior pupils in order for them to study and prepare for their Junior Cycle. As such, it is our intention to provide all books, workbooks, exam papers, copybooks, hardbacks, dictionaries, calculators, school journal, subject specific equipment and so on, to our 1st year pupils.

- This material remains the property of the school and can be requested for return at any time.
- All schoolbooks will need to be returned at the end of the 3-year cycle.
- School Books and materials will be provided ONCE ONLY, any materials that are lost or damaged will have to be replaced at a cost to parents.
- Parents of 1st year pupils should only need to purchase, whatever pens, pencils, pencil case and stationery you want your child to have.
- We intend to hand out School books and materials to 1st year students on Tuesday 20th August (assuming that materials are delivered on time by our supplier) we will update parents on this in mid-August when we know more.

Locker codes will be given out during the 1st week. A PE Locker is an optional extra, at a cost of €10 (from mid-August ring the school office to organise this).

An <u>information meeting for 1<sup>st</sup> Year Parents</u> will be held on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> September from 4.30-5.30pm – please make a note of this, as it is important that parents attend. The <u>1<sup>st</sup> Year Parent Teacher Meeting</u> is on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025.
