Dear Parents/Guardians,

We hope that your child has enjoyed another school year. Find below relevant information regarding back to school in August.

Our **school uniform** has been reviewed; please review the changes that have been made. See information letter that is available on our website. **I would draw particular attention to school skirts and jackets**

- Any pupil who wants to wear the school skirt must purchase the new skirt (below the knee) unless their current skirt length is to the knee.
- All pupils wearing skirts must pair them with black socks or black opaque tights (50 denier upwards).
- While a school jacket is not compulsory, if your child intends on wearing a jacket to school, this is the only jacket that will be permitted to be worn in school.

School Fees must be paid in full by Way2Pay before the 16th of August.

School fees for TY are €380 and cover Book Rental Books; School Insurance / Locker / Book Rental / Activities & Trips / School Journal / Texts / Printing & Photocopying.

It is expected that school buses will run as normal from Monday 26th August. For School Transport information contact Bus Eireann on www.buseireann.ie

Locker codes will be given out during the first week. A PE Locker is an optional extra, at a cost of €10 (from mid-August ring the school office to organise this).
